



Dog Licenses

It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to keep, harbor or maintain any dog within the corporate limits of the city regardless of whether in kennels or on a leash or chain unless first licensed; [GCMC 7.04.080](#).

Annual Fee

- Dog License \$15.00
- Dog License (Spayed or Neutered) \$5.00

Obtaining a License

- Licenses can be purchased at City of Grand Coulee City Hall, 306 Midway Avenue.
- Bring a copy of current rabies vaccination from your Veterinary Clinic.

License Renewal

- Licenses expire December 31st of each year.
- You can get your new year's dog license beginning in December by coming to the City of Grand Coulee City Hall, 306 Midway Avenue

7.04.080 License-Required. It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to keep, harbor or maintain any dog within the corporate limits of the city regardless of whether in kennels or on a leash or chain unless first licensed in accordance with this chapter. (Ord. 845 § 8, 1998)

7.04.060 License--Tag. The city clerk shall keep a record of all dog licenses showing the number of each license, the name and address of the applicant or owner, and the sex and general description of each dog so licensed. The city clerk shall issue a dog tag bearing the number of the license to the applicant or owner. Dog tags shall not be transferable from one dog to another. The city clerk shall not issue a dog tag or permit a dog to be licensed unless the owner or applicant provides the dog's vaccination record. (Ord.. 845 § 6, 1998)
