1. CALL TO ORDER:

2. **Workshop on City Infrastructure:** Gray & Osborne engineers, Mike Meskimen and Nancy Wetch, provided information on the city's water, sewer, wastewater and streets. Mr. Meskimen said that TIB does an annual assessment of the streets and rates their condition. Grant applications are based on the streets with the most need. Currently the city does not have a lot of stormwater drainage. Ms. Wetch recommends that the city apply for funding to create a water facility plan. Without a facility plan in place the city may not qualify for funding for needed repairs and upgrades. The telemetry system is not currently working correctly, the city may want to consider updating the telemetry system. The water reservoirs are twenty to forty years old, may want consider having them inspected.
